

Policy: Advanced Placement

Advanced Placement or transfer students are admitted on an individual basis. A student wishing to be considered for transfer must submit an official transcript including a course description. The Admission Committee will review the transcript and application and decide on the merit of such a transfer. A consideration for placement will always be the availability of placement within the program. A transfer student will only be considered if there is an opening in the class for which the student would like to gain admission. The program cannot exceed JRCERT enrollment standards.

The following are the minimum requirements for transfer:

Completion of the ASRT curriculum requirements of 15 credits:

Three credits must be in Freshman Composition/Oral Presentation

Three credits must be in College Math

Nine other credits are left to the discretion of the applicant

Grade Point Average: 3.0 from a previous accredited radiography program

Clinical Competencies 35 completed. (The competencies will be reviewed by Program Officials and some completed competencies may be required to be repeated.)
